## **Conditions of Entry**

1. Each photo can be entered in ONE class only.
2. A maximum of 5 photos can be entered in each class.
3. Photos may be taken at any time, but cannot have been exhibited in a previous Bourke show.
4. All entry money must be included with this form. If entry money is not complete, photos will be displayed, but will not be put forward for judging.
5. All photographs must be 10x15cm in size (unless enlargements) and mounted on cardboard with a 5mm-10mm border. No frames allowed. Clearly record your name and class number on the back of each photo.
6. Maximum size for enlargements is 30x25cm.
7. Stewards have the right to move photos to a more appropriate class as required.
8. Post-processing on computer/tablet is permitted, but AI editing is NOT permitted.
9. Juniors may enter in their relevant age group, or in the open section if desired.
10. Monochrome prints may be black & white or any varying tones of a single colour, such as sepia.
11. Selfies must be a self-portrait using either a hand-held device or a device attached to a selfie stick.
12. Landscapes and waterscapes MAY include man-made objects.
13. Still Life is a photo showing inanimate objects from the natural or man-made world.
14. Class 31 - Any Other Photo is a class for photos that do not meet the criteria for any other class.
15. Class 39 - Photo Essay – A set of photographs displaying a common theme, technique or sequence of events. The prints must be mounted on one piece of cardboard, maximum size 100x25cm. Maximum number of images in the photo essay is FIVE postcard prints. Photos may be colour or monochrome.
